

Shoreline and Property Rules 2021

Boats and Wave Runners (Jet Skis)

- Must have a **current permit** for watercraft and it **must be displayed**.
- **NO WAKEBOATS** or any boat with a **ballast compartment** that holds water, in use or not.
- **NO boats over 26 feet**, not including pontoon boats.
- **NO boats with more than one (1) gas motor**, not including pontoon boats.
- **All watercrafts** must travel in a **counterclockwise direction**.
- Must stay in the **main body of the lake** and remain **away from shorelines**.
- Watercraft **cannot go into coves** and make circles creating waves.
 - **COVES ARE A NO WAKE AREA.**
- **Maximum speed is 35 mph.**
 - If your boat or wave runner **cannot plane at this speed**, it is **not permitted** on the lake.
- **Obey all “NO WAKE” buoys.**

The City hopes you will obey the rules to protect the **shoreline and property** around the lake.
Rules are **subject to change**.

The City **reserves the right to revoke** boat and/or jet ski **permits and privileges at any time**.
